

What Wind-eze Gel Caps do To relieve the symptoms of stomach pain and bloating due to the presence of trapped wind.

The main ingredient is simeticone, an anti-flatulent, which works by gently dispersing the tiny bubbles of trapped wind, without the risk of embarrassment.

Do not take Wind-eze Gel Caps:

- **if you are allergic** to simeticone or any of the other ingredients.
- if you are under 12 years.

Take special care with Wind-eze Gel Caps

If symptoms persist for more than 14 days, or if symptoms worsen, medical advice must be sought.

Simeticone is inert and not absorbed into the body. Wind-eze soft gel caps are not known to cause any unwanted effects.

How to take Wind-eze Gel Caps

Adults and children aged 12 years and over: Swallow 1 capsule with a drink of water 3 or 4 times daily after meals and at bedtime as needed.

Not recommended for children under 12 years.

Do not exceed the stated dose.

Main ingredient Each capsule contains Simeticone 125 mg (activated dimeticone).

Other ingredients Gelatin, glycerol, titanium dioxide (E171) and purified water.

Keep out of the reach and sight of children. Do not use after the expiry date on the pack. Do not store above 25°C.
